OVERVIEW

- Food Stash rescues good food that would otherwise go to waste. We pick up healthy surplus food from retailers, wholesalers and farms, and deliver the food to dozens of charitable partner organizations and to households in need through our Rescued Food Boxes. We also run a weekly Rescued Food Market.
- We seek partnerships with values-aligned donors. When exploring partnerships and public recognition, we'll consider the donor's history with the environment and sustainability, Indigenous allyship, and relationships with marginalized communities.

- We can provide a tour of Food Stash or virtual lunch-and-learn for your team to see the impact of your donation.
- To be eligible for a tax receipt, donations must be voluntary and must not be from sales or fees. We can only issue tax receipts to the true donor; not to third parties.
